Question 1:

"It is written in article 4 that all correspondence and documentation within the submission shall be sent in english or translated into english and certified by a sworn translator.

could you confirm if document like:

- official registration certificate which has to be attached with the Annex 2.
- accounts issued on official form.
- official certificates of social charges payment

Must be translated and certified also. "

Answer 1:

Question 2:

In particular we cannot physically perform a 90 day stability test within the timeframe; we can however produce test reports demonstrating our marker's stability in real world projects. Would more general stability test results be acceptable?

Also, in order to provide a complete response to all requirements, we respectfully request an extension of the submission date of 2 weeks".

Answer 2:
