WHO WE ARE.

TEI, the preeminent association of in-house tax professionals worldwide, was organized in 1944. Its members are chief tax officers and other corporate and business employees who are responsible for the tax affairs of the leading companies in North America, South America, Europe, and Asia. (Attorneys and public/chartered accountants engaged in private practice are ineligible for membership.) TEI's 7,000 members represent more than 2800 companies. There are 57 chapters, including chapters in Canada (4), Europe, Asia, and Latin America. TEI is truly international in scope, with more than 18 percent of its members located outside the United States (Since its formation in 2005, the Asia Chapter has grown to 128 members.)

EDUCATION & NETWORKING.

TEI provides educational programs and services to its members and provides a forum for members to meet and share ideas with one another and with government officials. TEI conducts seminars, courses, and conferences on U.S., Canadian, state & local, and international taxation. The Institute hosts two major conferences each year: the Midyear Conference in Washington, D.C. in the spring and the Annual Conference in the fall. Local chapters meet monthly to discuss technical topics and interact regularly with federal, state, provincial, and local tax officials. Together, the Institute and its chapters hold more than 600 events each year.

ADVOCACY.

TEI participates in the development of tax policy and procedures on federal, state, and provincial levels in the United States, Canada, Europe, and Asia. The Institute's diverse membership gives the organization a unique perspective not only on administrative matters, but also on policy issues, particularly on technical regulatory issues under the purview of the U.S. Treasury Department and the Internal Revenue Service (and their non-U.S. counterparts). On key issues as diverse as simplification, penalties and other compliance measures, internationaland corporate taxation, as well as oversight, the Institute provides testimony and submits position papers to Congress and other international legislative bodies. TEI also hosts regular liaison meetings with representatives of the Internal Revenue Service.
