NB:

“Other” (for example 9+P1) is designed to give declarants the opportunity to mention a document that is not yet coded on the declaration. For example, a 35-character free text space is added to code **9+P1** (“+P” means that a parameter must be given, in this case the name of the document that is not yet coded, together with the identification data). If this space is inadequate, the rest of the text must be shown in the free text space of the code bearing a higher parameter number, in this case **9+P2**, etc.

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#### **4. "Other"**

“Other” (for example 9+P1) is designed to give declarants the opportunity to mention a document that is not yet coded on the declaration.

For example, a 35-character free text space is added to code 9+P1 (“+P” means that a parameter must be given, in this case the name of the document that is not yet coded, together with the identification data). If this space is inadequate, the rest of the text must be shown in the free text space of the code bearing a higher parameter number, in this case 9+P2, etc.
