

Conducting containers inspection – eLearning module

This easy-to-use eLearning module is one of the courses from an extensive EU eLearning programme on Customs and Taxation.

This course guides you through the containers inspection process and helps to learn how to assess the risks and examine a container effectively and safely.

Examining containers is a crucial element of the detection work of Customs officers **to protect the citizens and the territory of the EU** by:

- Detecting **evasion of customs duty payment** in relation to goods entering into the EU
- Detecting **prohibited, sanctioned or restricted goods**

To fully benefit of the potential of this course, we recommend to integrate the course in your own training programme and to develop a full blended learning programme.

Customs officers of national authorities.


Learning objectives

By the end of this course, you will:

- be aware of the potential for fraud related to the movement of containers;
- be aware of the role of Custom Officers in this context;
- know how to perform risk analysis;
- understand the important health and safety considerations when examining containers;
- recognise the various types of containers and associated issues of customs interest;
- know how to plan and organise the examination of a container;
- have a knowledge of correct examination equipment ;
- have learned how to examine a container internally and externally.

Course duration

The course takes 6 hours.



Particularities of this course

This course allows you to manage your own learning at your place: everything you need for this training is available on screen, some screens will require action from you. You can replay a screen if you need to.

You may interrupt your course. When reopening the course you can resume where you have left the course off.
