

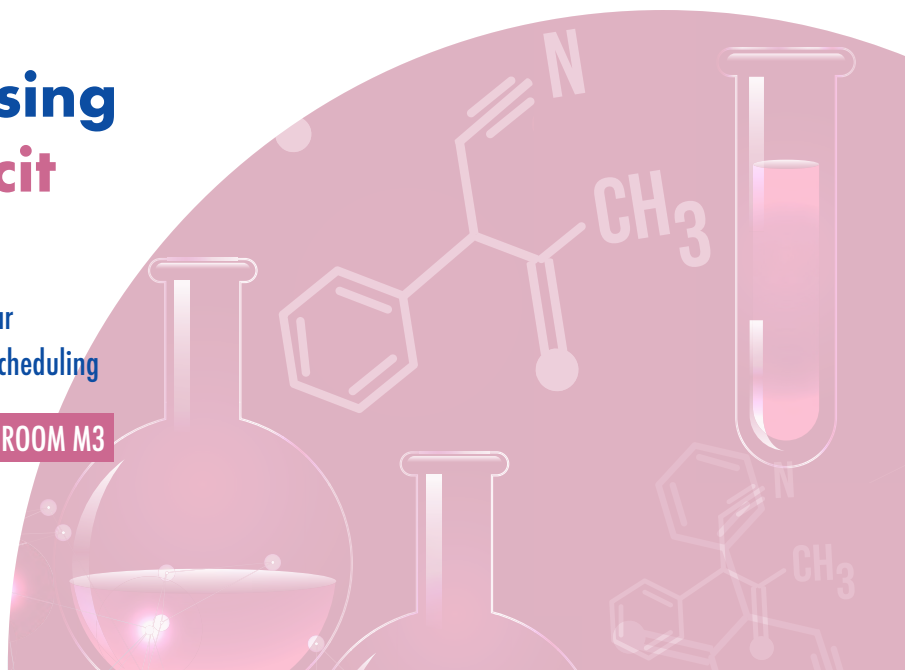


# Progress in addressing the evolution of illicit drug manufacture

Illicit drug manufacture continues to increase in extent, diversity and efficiency. This especially applies to the manufacture of synthetic drugs. Last year's [CND resolution 65/3](#) called upon Member States to intensify efforts to address the diversion of non-scheduled chemicals frequently used in the illicit manufacture of drugs and the proliferation of designer precursors. The resolution also outlined opportunities for proactive interventions and a number of tools and practical approaches.
