

# Car Search - eLearning module #2

## Rummage Vehicle Interior – (SRS) Supplementary Restraint Systems

This easy-to-use eLearning module is one of the courses from the EU eLearning training programme on **Car Search**, which includes 5 modules:

1. Basics of Vehicle Rummage (60 minutes)
2. **Rummage Vehicle Interior - (SRS) Supplementary Restraint Systems (150 minutes)**
3. Rummage Vehicle Exterior (120 minutes)
4. Rummage the Engine Compartment - Fuel Systems (130 minutes)
5. Rummage Special Vehicles (45 minutes)

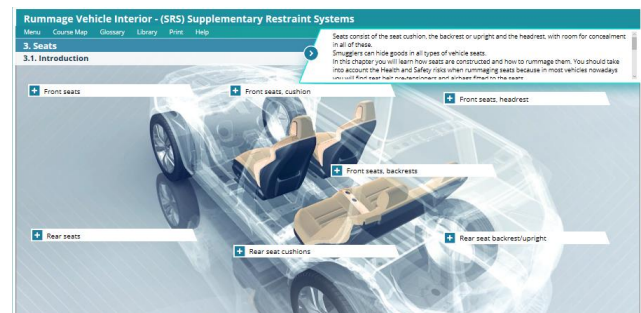
This programme is addressed to any officer who has to learn how to search a car in a safe and structured way.

The aim of searching a car is to establish if there are likely to be goods of customs interest found in it; or evidence of other associated activities.

To benefit fully from the potential of this course, we recommend to integrate the course in your own training programme and to develop a full blended learning programme.

### Course duration

The course takes around 2.5 hours.



### Target audience

As the course contains sensitive information, it is only available for national Customs administrations.

### Learning objectives

- When you have completed this course, you will:
- Know the **different parts of the interior** of the vehicle: doors, seats, dashboard, centre console, floors and sills, roofs and rear quarter panels;
  - Be trained to **rummage the interior** of the vehicle;
  - Know how the **interior spaces** are used for **concealment**; and
  - Know the importance to have sufficient **knowledge** and the proper **authorisation** when rummaging cars equipped with **SRS**.

### 11. Summary

#### 11.1. Key Points - Rummage Vehicle Interior

When considering conducting an interior rummage it is important to know where there are usable spaces. These can be model specific, although there are generic spaces in all models. This is where your experience and knowledge are very important.



Consider any **Health and Safety** implications, e.g. presence of airbags.



The **most likely places** for concealment would be doors, seats, floors and dashboards.



Use the **appropriate tools** to minimise any breakages.



Work **professionally** as a team member in a systematic and logical manner.
