Rummage the Engine Compartment - Fuel Systems

5. Rummage Special Vehicles (45 minutes)

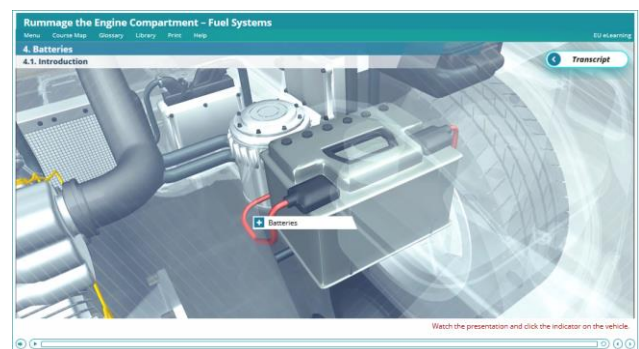
This programme is addressed to any officer who has to learn how to search a car in a safe and structured way.

The aim of searching a car is to establish if there are likely to be goods of customs interest found in it; or evidence of other associated activities.

To benefit fully from the potential of this course, we recommend to integrate the course in your own training programme and to develop a full blended learning programme.

Course duration

The course takes around 2 hours.



Target audience

As the course contains sensitive information, it is only available for national Customs administrations.

Learning objectives

When you have completed this course, you will:

- Be trained to rummage the engine compartment of the vehicle;
- Be aware of concealment possibilities at the different parts of the engine compartment of the vehicle: the car engine, the air filter, the battery, the air conditioning, the pollen filter and the windscreen wiper motor housing;
- Be trained to deal with a variety of fuel systems and possible concealments within.

12.1. Rummage Vehicle Engine Key Points Transcript

Engines run extremely hot, take care when working under the bonnet. Do not let ties or loose clothing get caught in the fan area at the front of the engine.

Always ensure that the **key or ignition device is secured** by another officer and not any of the occupants, at least 4-5 metres away from the vehicle.
