THE EU-CTC JOINT COMMITTEE,

Having regard to the Convention of 20 May 1987 on the simplification of formalities in trade in goods<sup>1</sup>, and in particular Article 11(3) thereof,

Whereas:

(1) Ukraine has expressed its wish to accede to the Convention of 20 May 1987 on the simplification of formalities in trade in goods ('the Convention') on [.....].

(2) The exchange of goods with Ukraine would be facilitated by a simplification of formalities which affect the trade in goods between Ukraine and the European Union, Iceland, North Macedonia, Norway, Switzerland, Turkey, Serbia and the United Kingdom.

(3) With a view to achieving such facilitation, it is appropriate to invite Ukraine to accede to the Convention,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

*Article 1*

Ukraine shall be invited to accede to the Convention in accordance with Article 11a of the Convention, as from ...

*Article 2*

This Decision shall enter into force on the date of its adoption.

### **Proposal for Decision No 2/2022 of the EU-CTC Joint Committee established by the Convention of 20 May 1987 on common transit procedure**

#### **as regards an invitation to Ukraine to accede to that Convention**

THE EU-CTC JOINT COMMITTEE,

Having regard to the Convention of 20 May 1987 on a common transit procedure<sup>2</sup>, and in particular Article 15(3), point (e), thereof,

Whereas:

(1) Ukraine has expressed its wish to accede to the Convention of 20 May 1987 on a common transit procedure ('the Convention') on [...].

(2) The movement of goods with Ukraine would be facilitated by a common transit procedure for goods transported between Ukraine and the European Union, Iceland, North Macedonia, Norway, Switzerland, Turkey, Serbia and the United Kingdom.

(3) With a view to achieving such facilitation, it is appropriate to invite Ukraine to accede to the Convention,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

#### *Article 1*

Ukraine shall be invited to accede to the Convention in accordance with Article 15a of the Convention as from ...

#### *Article 2*

This Decision shall enter into force on the date of its adoption.
