Information on the selection process - timeline

The deadline for submitting applications to the call for expression of interest expired on 31st of March 2016.

The applications are currently being examined.

Below is an <u>indicative</u> timeline for further steps in the selection of a substance suitable for use as a marker in gas and kerosene.

April-May 2016: Pre-selection of applications on the basis of documentation.

<u>End of May 2016</u>: Short list of candidate markers for testing. The candidates will be asked to submit substances for testing.

November 2016: Completion of the tests.

<u>End of 2016</u>: Presentation of results of the selection process to Member States and obtaining Member States' opinion on the selected substance.

First part of 2017: Assessment of the substance by SCHER.

Subsequently, if a better performing substance is identified, a decision designating the chosen substance as a common marker in accordance with the rules laid down in Article 43 of Directive 2008/118/EC needs to be presented by the Commission.

By the end of 2019: A certified reference material (CRM) will be available if a better performing marker can be found as a result of these tests.
