

# Entry of goods and Temporary storage eLearning module

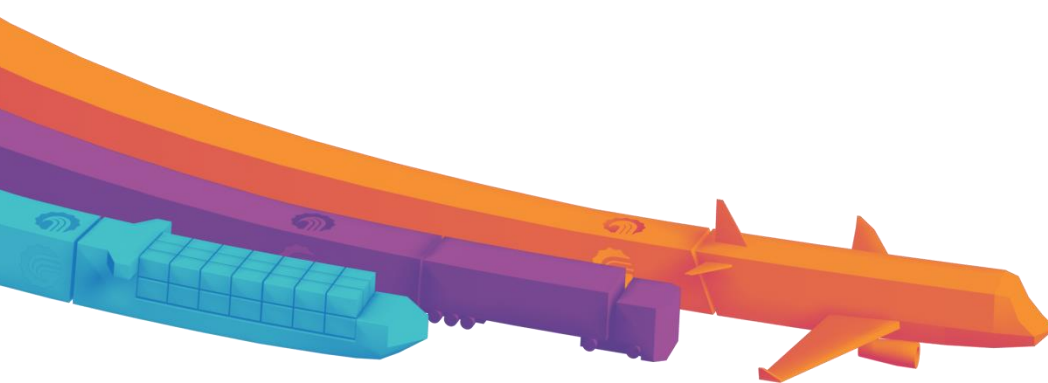

## Particularities of this course

As non-Union goods are automatically placed under temporary storage when entering the customs territory of the Union, this course deals with both the entry of goods (sections 2, 3 and 4) and the temporary storage (section 5).

You may however access the section of your interest by navigating through the menu.

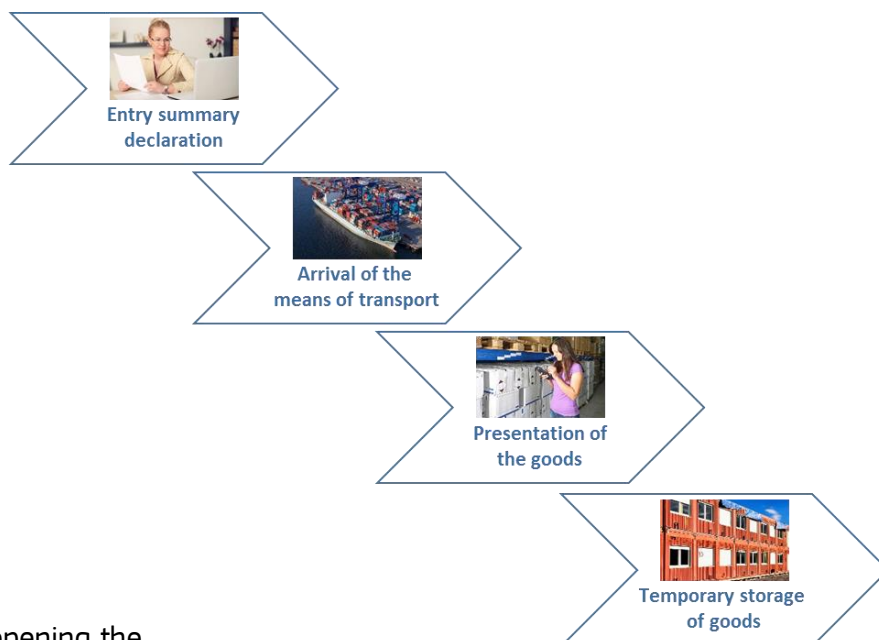
## General features
