⁶ To comply with Articles 15 and 16, and Appendix III of the Cameroonian Decree No 2016/367 of 3 August 2016 concerning the rules of origin, in regards the movement certificates entitled "EUR.1-CMR", EU exporters should add manually or by printing letters "CMR" to the existing movement certificate EUR.1 and have it confirmed by the customs authorities of the Member States concerned.
